

ORDINANCE NO. 967

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE JOHNSTON REVISED ORDINANCES OF 2007 BY AMENDING SECTIONS 157.03 AND 157.06 OF THE ELECTRICAL CODE TO UPDATE FROM THE NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE, 2011 EDITION, TO THE 2014 NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE AS ADOPTED BY THE IOWA STATE ELECTRICAL BOARD.

Be It Enacted by the City Council of the City of Johnston, Iowa That:

Section 1. PURPOSE. The purpose of this ordinance is to update the Electrical Code to reflect the 2014 edition of the National Electrical Code, as published by the National Fire Protection Association.

Section 2. AMENDMENT. Section 157.03 is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

“157.03 ADOPTION. The 2014 Edition of the National Electrical Code, as adopted by the State of Iowa Electrical Board with State Amendments, published by the National Fire Protection Association, except those provisions thereof which are hereinafter deleted, modified or amended, is adopted as and shall constitute the “Electrical Code of the City of Johnston, Iowa” to regulate the practice and materials used in the installation, maintenance, extension and alteration of all wiring, fixtures, appliances and appurtenances in connection with various electrical systems in the city. The same is, by this reference, incorporated in this chapter as fully and completely as if set forth in full in this chapter. The use of the term “National Electrical Code” in this chapter shall be interpreted to refer to the National Electrical Code, Current Edition.”

Section 3. AMENDMENT. Section 157.06 Deletions, Modifications and Amendments is hereby modified as follows:

1. Section 157.06(1), 120.1 Permit fees is modified by adding the following exception thereto:

“Those individuals holding a Residential Master Electricians License shall be able to only work on One (1) or Two (2, Duplex) family dwellings.”

2. Section 157.06(3) is deleted in its entirety and the remaining subsections thereafter shall be renumbered to reflect this deletion.

Section 4. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 5. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in full effect from and after July 1, 2017 and shall be automatically updated with amendments when subsequent Editions are adopted by the Iowa State Electrical Board.
